#### **PARTICIPATING COACHES WILL:**

- Attend and observe all classroom and field sessions in their respective event(s).
- Take part in interactive coaches "Rap Sessions."
- Receive written handouts and complete a follow-up evaluation.
- Have the opportunity to engage in informal discussions before, after, and between camp sessions with the instructor staff and other participating coaches.

#### **CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:**

Coaches will be selected based on their record of developing athletes in their respective event area(s) of expertise to the State and National levels, and their projected potential to develop future Olympic medalists. These camps are designed to enhance the expertise of current elite-level high school, club, and college coaches with the goal of them joining our nation's finest developers of Olympic World Championship medalists in their respective events.
